Mr. Brown is CEO of Ernest Brown & Company and provides Construction ADR, Project Risk Management, and Investigation Services Globally.

Mr. Brown has advised on more than \$10 billion in US and International construction projects. He has also been Chief Trial Counsel in global construction disputes such as the Central Arizona Project Pipeline failure (\$146 million, Defense Verdict) and the June 9, 1985, Southern California Edison Powerplant Disaster (\$250 million in property damage and six deaths; minimal settlement for his client).

He has been a panelist on the National Construction Panel for the American Arbitration Association since 1982 and an American Arbitration Association Large Complex Case panelist since 1993. He has mediated more than 800 complex construction cases on matters ranging up to \$100 Million.
