Nakul Dewan is one of the youngest to have been designated as a Senior Advocate by the Supreme Court of India. He is a Barrister at the leading commercial set, Twenty Essex, both in Singapore and London, and one of the only Indians to have rights of audience before courts in India, Singapore and London.

Nakul brings a significant level of experience to complex trials, interim applications, injunctions, appellate hearings, jurisdictional disputes and enforcement matters. He has appeared as lead counsel in setting aside and enforcement proceedings relating to international arbitration awards in all multiple jurisdictions.

He has been appointed as arbitrator by the SIAC, ICC and LCIA, and also accepts ad hoc appointments.

Nakul obtained his Bachelor's degree of Commerce from Shri Ram College of Commerce (SRCC, New Delhi) and his law degree from Faculty of Law, University of Delhi after which he obtained his Master's degree in law (LL.M.) at New York University and National University of Singapore. In addition to his practice of law, Nakul teaches a course on arbitration and international dispute resolution as an Associate Adjunct Professor at National University of Singapore (NUS) and publishes articles in various international journals in the field of arbitration. He is also a Chief Editor of the book "Enforcing Arbitral Awards in India (Lexis Nexis 2017)."
